I have received several comments from communities supporting the draft major drainage systems master planning needs list I emailed to you on July 16, 2013, and a few requests for minor changes to the list. As a result, the draft you received in July has been finalized and a copy of the final list is enclosed for your records. I appreciate your input in preparing this master planning needs projection for the next four years. A budget request for 2014 will be made in the amounts shown on the accompanying list and I am hopeful that the UDFCD Board of Directors will adopt it.

I will be contacting each community listed as a co-sponsor for projects in 2014 after the Board has taken final action on our budget. Should the Board approve a lesser budget amount for 2014 than the amount listed in this table, I will attempt to sort out the project priorities at that time.

The following is a list of the studies in which the City of Aurora will be involved along with my estimate at this time of your share of the local cost. Please keep in mind these are preliminary estimates for budgeting purposes; we can negotiate the final amounts when the study is about to begin.
